**NORTH TEXAS WHIP  
Liability Waiver for Willow Draw**

The parties to agreement are: 1. the organizers of this North Texas Whip sponsored event, the North Texas Whip, its Officers, Board of Directors and volunteers (hereinafter known as "the organizers") and 2. the Competitors, Grooms, Assistants, Family and everyone else who may have occasion to be on or about the property, carriages and/or equines (hereinafter known as "the participants").

**Recitals:**

- a. The landowners, **Tre' and Janet Book**, have granted permission for the organizers to hold a driving competition at their property called **Willow Draw, located at 573 North Bend Road, Weatherford, Texas 76085** and this permission has been extended on the express agreement that the organizers are to use the property and its facilities solely for the purpose of such driving event.
- b. The participants recognize that there is a risk of personal injury and property damage in connection with the holding of such driving event and, by executing this agreement and entering on the landowner's property; the participants assume all risk of injury in connection with such driving event.

**Now it is agreed that:**

1. The participants, their successors and assigns, hereby release the organizers, The North Texas Whip, the Committee, the Landowners, and all landowners over whose land the event shall be run, from any and all claims which they may have on account of any injury or damage suffered in connection with entering on the property or participating in the aforementioned driving event.
2. Each piece of property is unique in its configurations. However, each participant is responsible to make themselves and all working with them aware of the possibility of additional dangers at any ranch/farm/acreage such as open cattle and equine grazing pastures, unmarked vermin holes, steep banks, ravines, sand pits, slopes, bluffs, low hanging, fallen and falling branches; thorns of all kinds, ponds, areas with bad footing and barbed wire. Other dangers come from wild animals like deer and snakes or domesticated animals such as cattle, bulls, horses (mares, stallions and geldings), donkeys, birds, cats, dogs and pigs. This list is for example and not intended to be inclusive
3. Each participant agrees that the organizers shall not be responsible for any loss, personal injury or damage to people, horses or property brought onto the landowner's property or for any article of any kind of any nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. If the participant in any way does not want to accept these risks and the responsibility for all losses, they agree to not participate in the event, and to leave the property immediately.
4. All equines are brought on the property solely at the risk of their owner, and are to be handled, controlled and approached solely at the risk of their owner who shall be responsible for any and all loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property (including that of the owner) occasioned by him/her, his/her agents or employees or by any animal owned by him/her and shall hold harmless and indemnify the organizers against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned including, but not limited to, any and all legal costs, including attorney fees which may be incurred as a result thereof.
5. The UNDERSIGNED acknowledges that they are personally aware of the inherent risk involved in driving, riding, observing, working and being involved with and around horses, dangers or conditions which are an integral part of equine activities, including but not limited to: (1) The propensity of equines to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around them; (2) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement, and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; (3) certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions; (4) collisions with other equines or objects; (5) the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the animal or not acting within his or her ability; (6) equines are large animals, weighing between 300 and 1,500 pounds, with a very strong "Fight or Flight" instinct which they may act upon with little or no warning to those around them.
6. Under Texas Law (Chapter 87, civil practices and remedies code), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities. The UNDERSIGNED agrees to be held to this and any other applicable state laws regarding liability in equine activities of the State of Texas.
